Poetry Out Loud is a national program that encourages high school students to learn about great poetry—both classic and contemporary—through memorization, performance, and competition. Since the program began in 2005, Poetry Out Loud has grown to reach more than 4.1 million students and 68,000 teachers from 17,000 schools and organizations in every state, American Samoa, the District of Columbia, Guam, Puerto Rico, and the U.S. Virgin Islands.

Students participating in the 2024 Poetry Out Loud New York State Final are the winners from 9 regional semifinal competitions that took place across the state. The winner will go on to represent New York State at the national Poetry Out Loud finals in Washington D.C. from April 30 to May 2, 2024.
